- (9) I understand and agree that Millsaps College and all Millsaps personnel associated with the Program cannot make to me any promises or guarantees with regard to any health or safety risks which I may incur as a result of my participation in the Program.
- (10) As a student on a Millsaps-sponsored or Millsaps-approved program, I am subject to the Honor and Behavior Code specifying the regulations and consequences regarding academic and social conduct, alcohol use, drug use and behavior. Details of this code are listed in the Major Facts handbook. In the event of any violation of this code, I will be subject to the sanctions specified in the code in addition to those imposed by the program (as noted in these paragraphs).
- (11) I agree to abide by the requirements, rules and directions of the program and the program leaders, including (but not limited to) attending all classes and class-related activities. If I disobey such requirements, rules or directions, I may be sent home at my own expense, with no right to a refund of any part of the Program fee.
- (12) I understand and agree that if I become a threat to the well-being or safety of myself or the group, or if I conduct myself in a manner deemed by the program director to be disruptive or interruptive to the learning process, I will be immediately sent home at my own expense with no right to a refund of any part of the Program fee.
- (13) I agree to abide by all laws in the country I am visiting. If I disobey such laws, I may be sent home at my own expense, with no right to a refund of any part of the Program fee. In the event local authorities become involved, I understand I will be subject to the laws and penalties of the country I am visiting.
- (14) I understand and agree to be responsible for securing all necessary travel documents (e.g., passport, visa) for the Program. My failure to do so shall not constitute grounds for a refund except according to the normal cancellation guidelines established by the Program.
- (15) As a condition of my participation in the Program, I understand and agree that I am hereby waiving any and all claims arising out of or in connection with my travel to and from and/or my participation in the Program that I or my family, my heirs or my assigns may otherwise have against Millsaps College and/or its personnel.
- (16) I hereby release Millsaps and all of its representatives from, and agree not to sue them for, any claims arising from or in connection with any physical or property damage that I may suffer from any cause whatsoever other than the actual negligence of them.
