Areas with Wireless Access

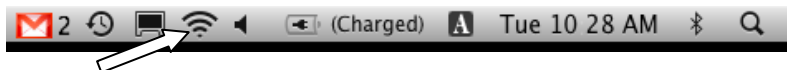
As the campus wide wireless plan nears completion areas will continuously be added to the list of active Hotspots. At this point connection to the wireless network is available in all academic, residential and instructional areas. The wireless can also be reached in athletic facilities, the Millsaps Bowl, and the Plaza, which is located adjacent to the Student Center and the HAC. Requirements for Access

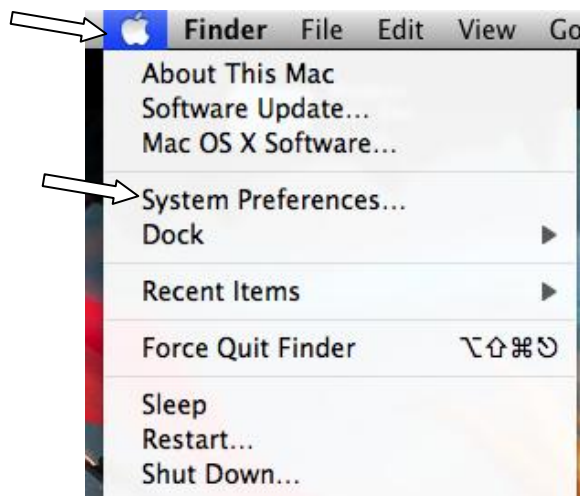
You must have a computer equipped with an 802.11b/g-compatible wireless card and the device's latest drivers. The supported encryption type is available only with Macintosh OS X 10.3.3 and greater. Due to updated networking preferences interface, this documentation applies specifically to OS X 10.5.4 and greater. The first step may be done anywhere. The last step must be completed while in a wireless enabled area.

Step 1 – Enabling your AirPort or other wireless card

Turn on your computer and make sure that the wireless card is activated. To do this **Click** the *AirPort status* icon on the menu bar located at the top. This icon is used to quickly change wireless settings and verify wireless connection status. If you see this icon, skip on to **Step 2 – Connecting to Major Air**.



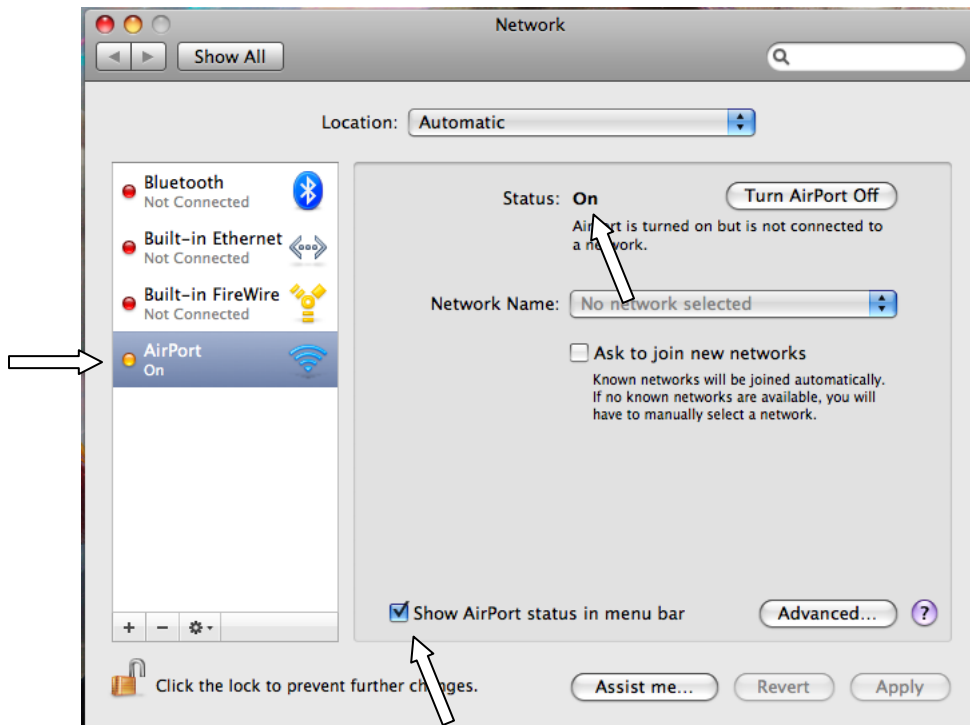
If the AirPort status icon is not on the menu bar, **select** the *Apple* | **Click System Preferences...**



In System Preferences **Select Network**.

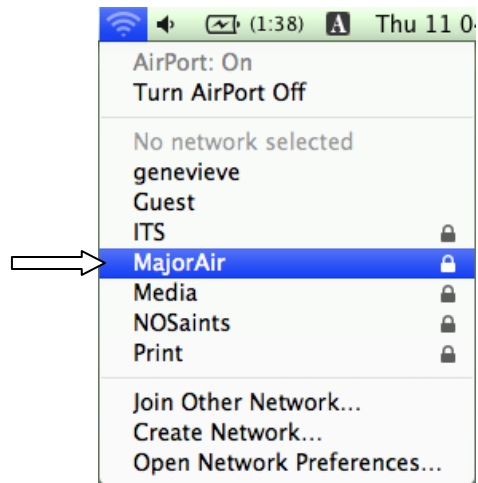


Next **Select AirPort** | **Check Show AirPort status in menu bar**. Ensure that the *Status* is *On*. If it is *Off*, **Click Turn AirPort On**.



Step 2 – Connecting to Major Air

Click the AirPort status icon | **Click** *MajorAir*. You may have to wait on AirPort to finish scanning for available wireless networks before MajorAir is an option.

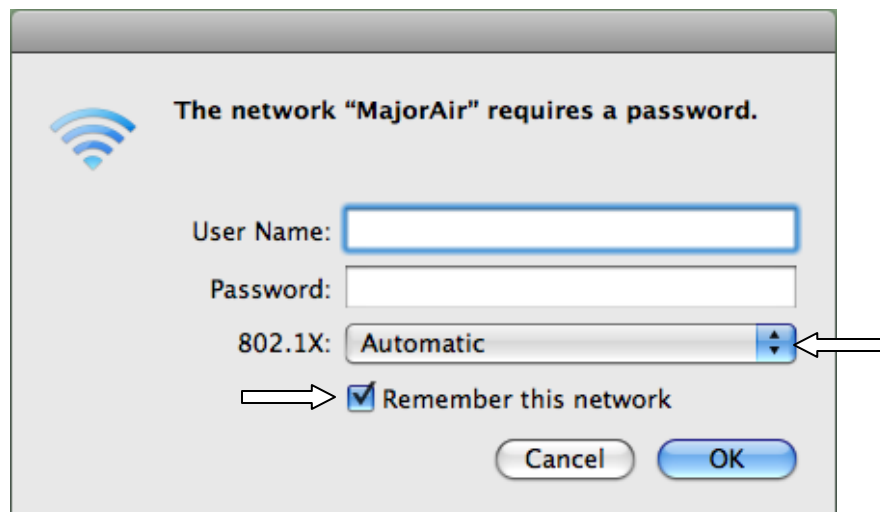


In the dialog box that opens, enter the following information:

User Name: Your Millsaps username

Password: Your Millsaps password

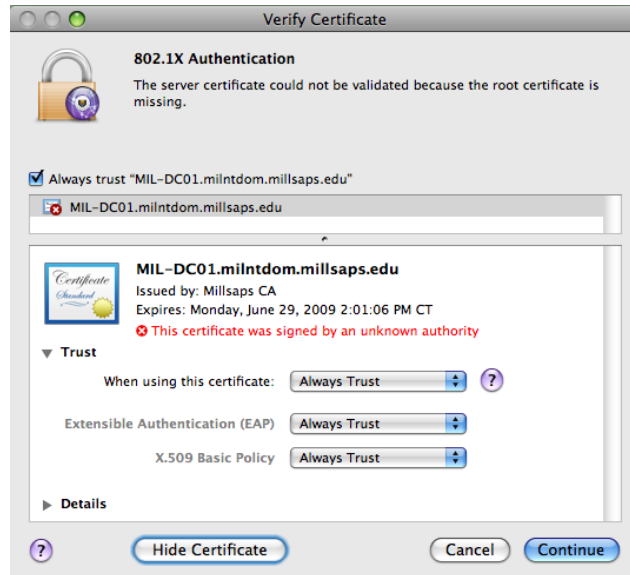
Select *Automatic* from the drop-down menu. **Check** *Remember this network*. **Click** *OK*.



In the "Verify Certificate" window, **click** Show Certificate.

Check Always trust "MIL-DC01.milntdom.millsaps.edu".

Click the arrow to expand the "Trust" section in the bottom window | **Select** Always Trust next to "When using this certificate:" | **Click** Continue.



Depending on your settings, you may be asked to enter your log-in name and password. This is not your Millsaps username and password, but the one you use on your Mac.

You should now be connected to MajorAir, where you can access your M: drive, use Entourage to check your mail, and access the Internet at high speeds. Note that wireless connection speeds can be intermittent, and for the best connection we recommend the wired network connection.
