Charles Betts Galloway was born in Kosciusko, Mississippi, on September 1, 1849. He graduated from the University of Mississippi in 1868 and also received his D.D. there in 1882. Galloway was admitted to the Mississippi Conference in 1868. By 1882, he was made editor of the *New Orleans Christian Advocate*. Galloway became the youngest man elected to the episcopacy in 1886. He was noted for his oratorical ability and delivered such lectures as the Cole Lectures at Vanderbilt and the Quillian Lectures at Emory as well as the opening address at the third Ecumenical Methodist Conference in London in 1901. Galloway was one of the founders of Millsaps College and served as president of the General Board of Education and the board of trustees for Vanderbilt University and Soochow University in China. Galloway College in Arkansas and Galloway Memorial Methodist Church in Jackson, Mississippi, were named in his honor.
