M 95 HINTON, (Virginia Guerry) and GUERRY (Rev. Newton Dunn and wife Marie Judd) Garments, c. 1850-1920

In 2006, Virginia Guerry Hinton gave family christening gowns used by her, her mother, her grandmother, and her great grandfather to be preserved in the Methodist Archives in memory of her parents, Rev. and Mrs. Newton Guerry. Rev. and Mrs. Guerry served in the North Mississippi Conference until his death in 1968. Mrs. Guerry followed in 1970.

William Hodges, known as Bus and Buster. Hi is the father of Clara Virginia
Hodges Judd

Item 4 Long christening gown

Marie Judd Guerry, wife of Rev. Newton Dunn Guerry and mother of Virginia
Guerry Hinton
