Bishop Clay Lee earned his Bachelor of Divinity from the Candler School of Theology at Emory University. He served appointments in Unity, Jackson (on Capital Street), Raymond, Quitman, Philadelphia, and Jackson (Leavell Woods). He served as the executive director of the Mississippi Conference Council on Ministries and as the superintendent of the Brookhaven District before his 12-year tenure at Galloway Memorial United Methodist Church in Jackson. He was elected Bishop in 1988 and assigned to the Holston Conference. He chaired the Board of Pensions and Health Benefits, Benefits 2000 Task Force, Joint Committee on Communications, Appalachian Development Committee, and the Southeastern Jurisdiction College of Bishops. He is the author of *Jesus Never Said Everyone Was Lovable*, based on a series of sermons broadcast on *The Protestant Hour*. He was Bishop in Residence at Galloway from 1996 to 2000 and is currently Bishop in Residence at Millsaps College in Jackson. Clay Lee married Dorothy Stricklin in 1951; they have five children.
