Jordan Allen Lindsey, Jr. (1912-1991) was a minister of the Mississippi Conference United Methodist Church and also spent over 30 years as a member of the Conference Commission on Archives and History and the Southeastern Jurisdiction Historical Society. He was the author of *Methodism in the Mississippi Conference, 1895-1919*; *Methodism in the Mississippi Conference, 1920-1939*; *History of the Seashore Assembly Grounds*; *Chronicles of the SEJ Historical Society*; and contributed to such periodicals as *Encyclopedia of Methodism* and *World Parish Magazine*.
