Frank and Martha Ann Marchetti were founding members of Hazlehurst United Methodist Church and preserved printed material relevant to their service within the church. Their children were Frank, Jr., Robert E., Mary, Irene, Kate, John, Joseph, and George. Their grandson, Robert Gray Marchetti, son of Robert E and Mildred Gray Marchetti, and his wife Jackie, donated the Papers from the family home in Hazlehurst. The scope of the collection comprises Sunday School literature, Bible study teaching guides, periodicals and books published by the Methodist Episcopal Church, South 1903-1930, and the Methodist Church 1947-1978. Subjects of interest include missions (W.R. Lambuth, Galloway, China, Brazil, Japan, other), graded lessons, support for retired preachers and widows, evangelical movement in the denomination, opposition to the plan of re-unification. There is also one item from Hazlehurst UMC. Other Methodist materials from the Marchetti family may be located at Hazlehurst UMC.
