Rev. Summer Walters, native of Simpson County, is a graduate of Millsaps College, Class of 1957. His wife, Elizabeth (Betty) Barfield Walters graduated from Millsaps in 1956. Rev. Walters earned a Bachelor of Divinity, 1960, and Master of Sacred Theology, 1961, at Yale University. From June, 1961- June, 1963, he was the associate pastor at Jefferson St. Methodist Church in Natchez, MS, serving with Rev. Clyde Gunn. In January, 1963, Rev. Walters was one of 28 signers of the "Born of Conviction" statement of conscience that affirmed the Social Creed of The Methodist Church, objecting to the use of church buildings for private schools to avoid desegregation, and upholding the principles of equality of all God's children, freedom of the pulpit, and all Methodist property being open to all people without regard to race, creed or color. Rev. Summer Walters left the Mississippi Conference in 1963, transferring to the South Indiana Conference. Rev. Walters died in 2010. Mrs. Walters resides in Franklin, Indiana.
