Winnie Ellis Phillips died of congestive heart failure on August 10, 1999. She was a native of Leake County. She graduated from Leake County Agricultural High in Carthage. Also, she attended East Central Community College, Draughon's Business College in Jackson, and Mississippi College in Clinton. She worked for Capital Electric Power. Mrs. Phillips was a member of Christ United Methodist church in Jackson and was the historian for the Mississippi Conference of United Women for 12 years. Her book on Methodist Women was published in 1980. Others books she wrote include a book that documented the history of rural electrification in Mississippi from 1934-70 and the history of the Robert Thomas Ellis family of Leake County.
