

**Millsaps College Summer 2021
Piano Chamber Music Camp*
July 26-30, 2021**

The Millsaps College Summer Piano Chamber Music Camp is a weeklong camp for young pianists created to promote and encourage the development of piano chamber music performance. Students who are rising 7th through 12th graders will have the opportunity to work with Millsaps piano faculty. In a supportive atmosphere of collaborative music-making. The daily schedule includes ensemble coaching, classes, and rehearsals, master classes and performances by the faculty.

Admission Requirements

Student performers must have at least two years of experience in private lessons. To reserve your place, **please send applications in before June 28th along with a nonrefundable deposit of \$100**, which will be applied to the tuition. **Full payment of tuition is due by July 12th.**

Fees

Tuition is \$250. If a student is using the Bach Festival Scholarship awards, these payments will be sent directly to Millsaps College.

Withdrawal from Camp

Once registered, campers are arranged into small ensembles. A student's withdrawal from the camp will affect the ensemble to which he or she has been assigned. Please notify Rachel Heard immediately if you are unable to participate in the camp for any reason. **Refunds will be allowed until June 28th. After that time no refunds will be given.**

The Program

Chamber Music Coaching Sessions

Prior to camp, each student will be placed in two ensembles, according to his/her level of performance and study. Students will be sent their ensemble music for study and preparation with their private teachers. During the camp, the faculty will work on this special material with each ensemble and in master classes. Ensembles will also be given time to rehearse on their own and as a group throughout the week.

Music Theory, History, and Special Topics Classes

Each day two hours will be devoted to providing the students with an essential understanding of music theory and history. These are introductory classes; no prior experience in the subjects is necessary. Special Topics classes will introduce students to other aspects of music making.

Performance Opportunity

To conclude the week, all student ensembles will present their work in recital, Friday, July 30th at 3:00 pm in the Millsaps Academic Complex Recital Hall. All parents, family and friends are invited to attend. There will also be a student solo recital at 12:30 pm on Thursday, July 29th where students may present one of their solo pieces in recital for the other campers.

Faculty Recitals

During the week of camp, members of the faculty will present chamber music recitals at 12:30 pm. Students will be able to observe up close the art of creating music in the chamber setting. These recitals will be held in the Millsaps College Academic Complex Recital Hall, and are open to the public.

Drop off and Pick up Schedule

All students are allowed to be dropped off each day, between 8:30-9:00 am, with pick up between 3:30-4:00 pm
